

**Great Peninsula Conservancy (GPC) is a non-profit, 501(c)3 land trust working to protect the natural habitats, rural landscapes, and open spaces of the Great Peninsula of west Puget Sound, Washington.**



GPC has a 22-year track record of success working with partners to protect more than 10,900 acres of ecologically important forests, estuaries, and salmon streams. GPC aims to **conserve** the land and waters you love, to **steward** those lands in perpetuity, and to find creative ways to **connect** local community members with their environment.






